SAFETY

For safety and security, only those staying onsite can access the accommodation during the weekend. Please do not go into a House that you are not assigned to. In case of emergency and the need to evacuate, a Halberg staff member will be responsible for ensuring all buildings are safely cleared.

Please look after each other during the weekend and if you see anything that you deem not safe then please alert a Halberg staff member. You are responsible for keeping your possessions safe and secure. The swimming pool is out of bounds outside of swimming events.

ACCOMODATION

For those staying onsite at Rangī Ruru, accommodation has been allocated by regional team. Those requiring accessible rooms have been allocated accordingly.

BATHROOMS AND SHOWERS

We will have one accessible bathroom/change and four accessible toilets, around the accommodation and sport venues. The shower facilities will be busy so please be considerate of others when using these. If you can use non-accessible facilities, we would encourage that and have shower chairs and stools onsite to assist.

No drugs, alcohol or smoking are permitted anywhere on site, throughout the weekend. If you are concerned that these substances are present, please contact a Halberg staff member.
